Summary: 6th March Monthly Meeting

- Finance update €4,578.49 balance in the bank account as at 28th February
- Update on the school extension and resource letter that the PA sent to the BOM of CCC:
 - The BOM were informed that no application had been made by the patron (DDLETB) to the Dept of Education to commence the process of providing additional accommodation. The consequences of this are as follows:
 - That currently 240 new students enrol in 1st year however in 2024 this will be considerably less
 - The the school wishes to provide classes for students with special educational needs but cannot do so until the new classes are
 - Further Updates will be provided as they arise
 - The PA may need to take a more active / leadership role

Why are we doing this


- Our major fundraiser, profit of €24k in 2022



What preparation todate - Cake / Cupcake Competition

- Entries open to all CCC students
- Theme: Spring Flowers
- Entrants should make a cake or a minimum of 6 cupcakes (no maximum!). All entries should be dropped into the Café at the Plant Sale between 10am & 12pm on Saturday 6th and Sunday 7th May

- Multiple entries allowed.









What support we need before the big event



- Deliver Flyers to 9,000 homes
- Give out posters to shops, clubs, businesses in the locality to display
- Push the students to returns tickets (went out Thursday 20th April)
 - 1,300 students X 1 Book X €10 = €13,000
- Spread the word re volunteers, tell your friends
- Tell everyone about the event





What support we need at the big event

- Set up of school hall on Friday 6th from 4pm
 - Tables
 - Plants on tables, walls, floor when deliveries arrive
 - Compost to the front
 - Require 25 People
- Saturday 6th and Sunday 7th we need circa 35 Volunteers per shift
 - Morning shift 9:30-1:00
 - Afternoon shift 1:00-5:00
- Roles plant sellers/cake sale/cash desk/parking attendants/compost sales/BBQ etc
- Sunday tidy up Require 30 People @ 5:00 could happen earlier
