- Update of key points from the January 2024 PA was given.
- Parental Talk to be given by Glenna Benson on Wednesday 21st February. Glenna will
 deliver a talk on effective communication and how we can provide our children with the
 support they need as they navigate their journey to adulthood. She will speak about
 how effective communication can enable us to gain a deeper understanding of
 challenging behavior, stress and anxiety.
- Paul Fallon provided an update on the annual plant sale raffle hybrid solution and how
 we will use iDonate as the online provider but also be able to sell physical tickets based
 on his previous successful experience with Castleknock GAA.
- Plan to have 1st year coffee morning on a Friday before Easter if possible.
- The Treasurer provided an update on Finances with a closing balance of €4,011.82 as at the 31/01/24. There is a further donation of €1,000 due in and a cheque to be cashed of €184.38 for our Zoon licence fee, so the expected future balance is €4,827.44.

- The Chair thanked everyone who volunteered to be a readers at the mock exams or future exams. 8 new parents read for students & another 5 parents volunteered but were not available this time round. Volunteers are always welcome.
- Mr Cronin's gave an update on school activities
- Communication updates from the Department of Education ongoing in relation to additional accommodation. Department has communicated a commitment to deliver.
 Both modular and long-term additions discussed at the monthly PA meeting.
- Enrolment process for 210 first years continues, entrance test complete and options process commencing.
- Senior Cycle options process commenced TY provisionally capped at 160 students (TBC).



- Wellbeing Week Monday 22nd to 26th January 2024 took place and was a great success.
- LCA National Awards 2023 Athlone January 2024. Five of the Class of 2023 received the Fergal Quinn Award for Excellence.
- Three students from the Class of 2023 to be presented with entrance scholarships to Trinity College in March
- There was also a number of updates on the performance of the various College teams across various sports and age grades.



- Uniform tender working group established comprising teachers, parents & management. Meeting held on Monday 29th January and tender process is completed and report is being finalised.
- Child Protection & Counter Bullying Policy:
 - Copies of 2024/25 Child Safeguarding Statement & Risk Assessment Documents were reviewed approved by the BOM, copies presented by the Principal to the Chair off the PA.
 - Copies of Counter Bullying review and new Counter bullying policy were also presented by the Principal to the Chair of the PA.
- Following the theft of 3 bikes within the College the Principal would be asking the PA for support to fund an upgrade to the CCTV system in the College.


