Jigsaw Dublin 15 is part of a national network of Jigsaw Services supported by Jigsaw - The National Centre for Youth Mental Health. Jigsaw Dublin 15 aims to provide a tailored community-based support for young people's mental health needs. We first opened our doors in May 2013 and since then we have directly/indirectly supported almost 2,000 young people. Our team is made up of professionals with experience in the mental health, youth & community and healthcare sectors.
