



Update on Calculated Grades for LC2 Parents & Students

Dear Parents & Students,

I am writing to provide you with a brief update with regard to “Calculated Grades for Leaving Certificate 2020”.

As you are aware, on Friday 8th May the Minister for Education announced that the 2020 Leaving Certificate has been cancelled and will be replaced with new arrangements to include “Calculated Grades”.

I hosted a Microsoft Teams meeting on Wednesday 13th May with all LC2 students and made a commitment to host a second Online Meeting when I had received further clarification.

As of today Tuesday 19th May I have received no further updates on how the College is to proceed with the process of Calculated Grades. However, it is expected that further details will issue from the Department of Education & Skills in the coming week.

I have received many emails from students regarding the process and the key concerns relate to “change of level” & “subjects studied outside of school especially native-tongue languages (Russian, Romanian, etc). I hope to have further clarification on these and other issues in the coming days.

I will text all parents to alert them to the next Microsoft Teams Meeting.

I would also like to use this opportunity to thank all of you for your understanding and consideration at this time.
