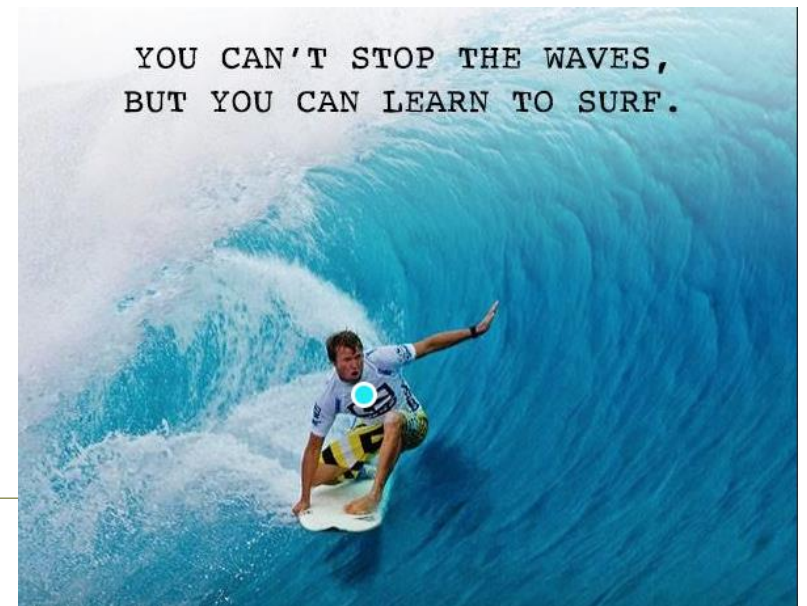
BOM Update re Extension & Resources - Update
